- ▶ Check with your doctor if you are eligible
- ▶ Get the necessary documents (**NCIS Request Memo & Lab Request Form**) from NCIS Clinic
- ▶ Turn up at one of the selected polyclinics and head straight to **NHG/ NUHS Diagnostics (Laboratory) Reception Counter** with your **NRIC & necessary documents**
- ▶ Get your blood test done

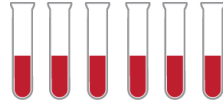
No payment required at polyclinic!
